Marriage is a unique and important event in the life of a human being. No one wants to get married on a whim and no one wants to fail in their marriage. Some would say that after birth, marriage is an equally important step, because two people come together to become one. Like a newly born baby, you will have to learn to walk together, think while including the other, live together and communicate.

Our individual cocoon becomes a love nest, the self becomes a we; and our interests and motivations must be considered for two people.

Today, the world feels entitled to criticize and talk about what a marriage should be. However, we all know that the wedding day is not the wedding itself. The best advice is to do what fulfills your heart's desire.



Do what you want, imagine yourself in 5 years, 10 years and have no regrets. Small wedding? Big wedding? The important thing is that your relationship is happy. What ultimately makes a couple happy? Is it true that nothing else matters? I would like to add a nuance to this.

It is true that the most important thing is the couple, but it is also common to want to please the people who are dear to us. I take the example of parents, close family or whatever the family context. Often, beautiful stories include family, such as dancing to your dad's favorite song or paying tribute to a deceased loved one. If I take my experience as an example, my father gave me a list of 20 people. These people were completely unknown to me by face. At first, I wondered why invite 20 more people I don't know, since my seats were already a little tight. I didn't want to, I was drastic and it took us several conversations before we changed our minds.

Let me tell you that saying yes to my father was the best choice in the world. After sending out these invitations, he was detail-oriented and contributed even more to the expenses than before. Arriving on the big day, in the evening at the reception room, I went to greet my guests and I finally understood. One of them had been his boss for 30 years and my father had himself attended his daughters' wedding, others were childhood friends from his native country who had participated in his upbringing, others were people who welcomed him here when he had just immigrated. In short, you understand the picture...

When I looked at my father's face, I saw pride and joy, that famous feeling of accomplishment that a traditional parent looks forward to. For nothing in the world, I would take away or replace this moment. As the youngest of four children, I would pay to see my parents' faces again that day. It was an extraordinary lesson and I met people, actors in my parents' lives who had ultimately contributed greatly to my story.



I know this is not a common consideration, but think about it. An only daughter, for example, marriage is not just her marriage, but it is the joy of an entire family. The phrase "Marriage is not just the big day, it is a lifetime of commitment" is true and takes on its full meaning here. Knowing that the big day does not make your relationship what it is and will be. Knowing that it is a way to please ourselves, to emphasize love and to be proud, I see no objection to pleasing our loved ones. The danger would be to forget oneself and not be happy because of external conditions. As in all things, balance is essential. While some are willing to suffer for the beauty of a pair of high heels and getting the perfect photo, others choose comfort to not worry about details throughout the day and be focused on the present moment. Can we judge this choice? Quite the contrary! The important thing is to know yourself and take complete responsibility for yourself.



We also have the reflex to prioritize the woman and ensure that she is the queen of the evening. There was a period in my life when I coordinated several weddings. From preparation to management of the procession, one common point always came up. When the groom was neglected, he made it felt! It's not just the bride's day, but the couple's. The man tends to be gallant on the wedding day and prioritize what the woman wants, and that is very good. On the other hand, let's avoid discriminating or minimizing male desires. Sometimes it comes down to breaking into a song with "the boys", having a perfect photo with their mother or simply being treated with such class and feeling that the present moment outweighs the money invested. How many times have I had a conversation the same evening with the bride and groom saying: "Well, she's happy, that's what counts, but I would have liked this or that..." I think that one day D should be successful. include both parties and that one person's compromise has no place here.



I know my approach isn't necessarily what you're used to reading, but these are the words of a woman on the ground. My husband and I have been in the wedding industry for about ten years and I refused to write you an article "just for show". Again, balance and consideration for both parties will help you have a memorable day. All of this comes down to good communication. Hoping that you will appreciate my little tips, we will certainly meet again in a future edition.

- HOW DID YOU MEET EACH-OTHER ?

-Actually, we've known each other forever. Our parents went to the same church. His mother kept me in the nursery. I used to go to soccer matches with my father in which Jean-Claude was a starting goalkeeper. Plus, his team was made up of my many cousins who played there. Growing up, we didn't talk to each other; given our age difference or probably the lack of interest we had in each other at the time. When I entered CEGEP, I saw him one day in the distance in a counter as I was leaving one of my classes. I recognized him and went to greet him. It was since then that our love story began.



- HOW DID YOUR MARRIAGE PROPOSAL GO 25 YEARS AGO?

Since we started dating, Jean-Claude spoke to me constantly and enthusiastically about marriage and the desire to start a family. I felt a lot of maturity and seriousness in this decision. I knew he was READY!!! For my part, I also felt that I was ready despite my 19 years of age; but it was important to me to finish my college education first. We had to make a compromise (because Mr. absolutely wanted to get married the following summer) that I had to at least finish my 2nd year of college studies. We therefore decided to get engaged on August 11, 1996 and we got married on August 2, 1997. The marriage proposal therefore took place in front of our families and friends on the day of our engagement.



-HOW DID YOU CHOOSE YOUR DRESS OF THE TIME?

My mother and my wedding godmother were the people who accompanied me while shopping for my dress. Back then, I wanted to look like a queen with the puffy, beaded, sparkly dress accompanied by the sparkly tiara and long long train. I found them all in just 1 day of shopping in a store in Plaza St-Hubert which belonged at the time (25 years ago) to a lady from our community and who unfortunately the store subsequently closed.



- CAN YOU TELL US ABOUT YOUR CHOICE OF RECEPTION VENUE AND DECORATION AT THE TIME?

25 years ago, choosing our reception location was very easy. The year before our wedding, a friend of mine had gotten married there and we decided to choose the same location given the large space; because we knew we were going to have over 400 guests. The reception took place at City Hall in Ville Mont-Royal. As for the decoration, one of my cousins' wife had a wedding decoration company with her sisters (still to this day) and they were the ones who did the decoration for our wedding day. It was wonderful..





-WHAT ARE THE MOST MEMORABLE THINGS ABOUT YOUR WEDDING DAY?

The entrance to the big procession, the entrance with my father, JC's first kiss on my forehead (yes...) The musical choice for all the entrances and exits from the procession. My preparation: makeup, hairstyle, clothing....Transport in a convertible Beetle car when it wasn't raining...of course

-IS THERE ANYTHING YOU WOULD HAVE DONE DIFFERENTLY ON YOUR WEDDING DAY, LOOKING BACK ON IT NOW?

YES. Paid invitation to reduce the number of guests: done for our 25th Choose my own photographer and videographer to capture all the memories: done for our 25th, First Class Pictures.

Choose a reception room that offers everything: made for our 25th (Plaza Rive Sud) because for our wedding, it was my husband's aunt who made the food and we had to take out a contract to have servers; in addition to renting all the crockery because the hall provided nothing other than the room, tables and chairs.

Take a Wedding Planner: made for my 25th, Marilyn Signature



WHAT ADVICE WOULD YOU GIVE FOR COUPLES PREPARING TO GET MARRIED?

You have to be ready to make compromises both during preparation for the big day and during married life of course. This will require you to respect your budget and plan for the unexpected. Maybe you couldn't have it all!!! That's life.

Also, when we decide to get married, we should no longer be in the I, ME, ME... it's WE. You must learn to crush your pride and demonstrate great wisdom. Of course, if the COUPLE wants it. :) And above all, put God at the center of your relationship.

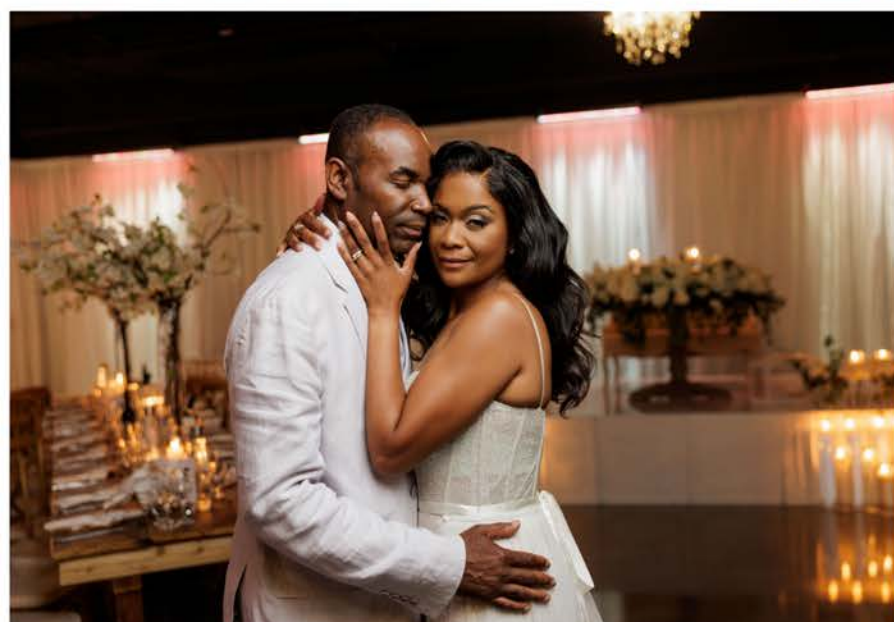
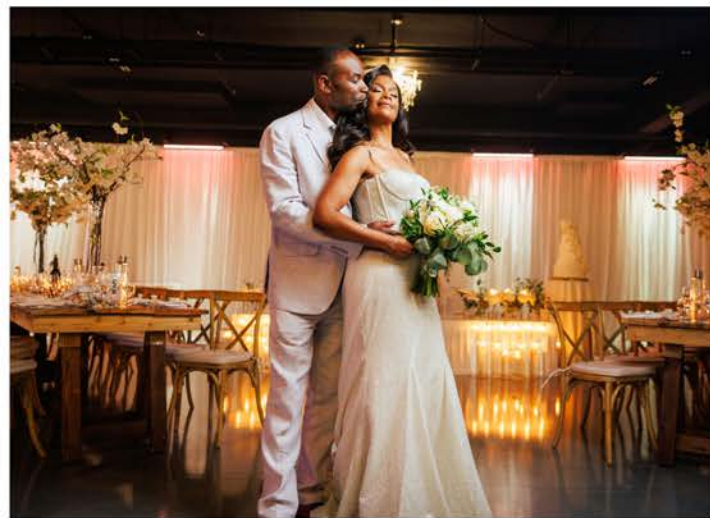

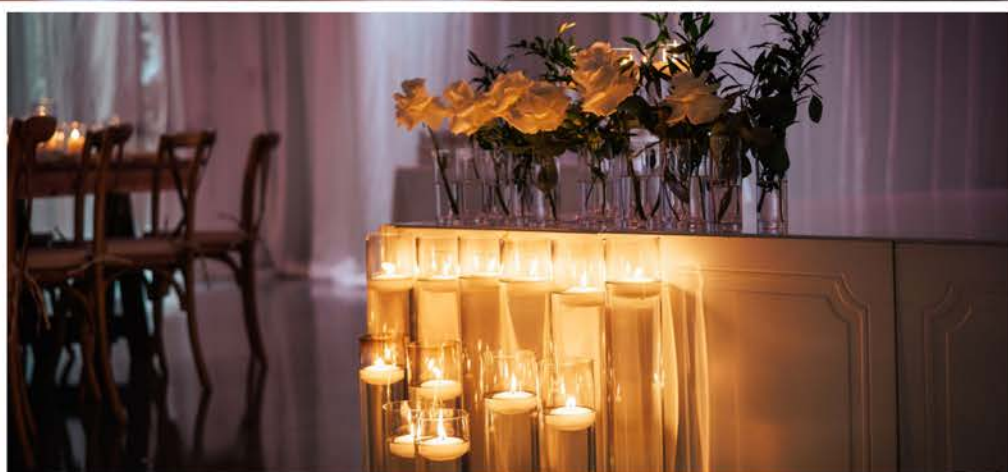

-HOW DID YOUR MARRIAGE PROPOSAL GO?

The proposal was super intimate! Bertho had planned everything with our immediate families, at my parents' house. Everyone knew except me!

BRIDE: HOW DID YOU CHOOSE YOUR DRESS?

Choosing my dress was quite an experience! I always wanted to have two styles for my wedding, one for the ceremony and one for the reception. I bought two dresses in November 2021, only to completely change my mind and buy another 2-in-1 dress in February 2022 😂. That's when I really fell in love at first sight and said yes to THE dress! Contrary to what those around me thought, my dress was very simple but elegant.



GROOM: HOW DID YOU CHOOSE YOUR SUIT?

For my part, choosing my costume was rather simple since I am co-owner of a custom costume making company, François Bertho. For the ceremony, I opted for a classic, black, timeless look. As for the reception, I chose a more extravagant, but subtle model.



-BRIDE: HOW WERE THE BRIDESMAIDS' DRESSES CHOSEN?

Choosing dresses for my bridesmaids was quite easy, because I wanted to respect each person's personality and body shape. I didn't want a uniform procession!

I opted for the burnt orange color and a satin fabric to highlight the different shades of melanin of the young ladies. I gave them the choice to select the model that suited them best.

-GROOM: HOW WAS THE CHOICE OF THE GROOMSMEN'S COSTUMES MADE?

Still tailor-made by François Bertho *2*, we based ourselves on the color of the bridesmaids to select autumn shades. I wanted a casual look for the groomsmen, so no ties or bow ties. On the other hand, I wanted to maintain a classic touch by adding a tone-on-tone belt with the color of the suit, dark green.

-CAN YOU TELL US ABOUT YOUR CHOICE OF RECEPTION VENUE AND DECORATION?

The choice of the location was a favorite, our objective was to maximize time with our procession and our guests while minimizing travel. So we chose a location where the ceremony and reception were possible, and the Golf Métropolitain was perfect! When it came to the decor, we wanted to keep it simple and clean. Greenery and white were therefore in the spotlight.





-HOW DID YOU CHOOSE YOUR PHOTOGRAPHERS AND VIDEOGRAPHERS?

The choice of photographer/videographer was not very complicated since we knew Johnny from First Class pictures of the church and we had done a photoshoot with him in the summer of 2020. Having seen the super clean work of First Class, we decided was told it wasn't a question. We contacted him the week after the marriage proposal!

-MARRIED:WHAT WERE THE BIGGEST CHALLENGES OF PREPARATION?

In our opinion, the biggest challenges of preparation are time management, managing the guest list and financial investments. We're not going to lie, a beautiful wedding is expensive! Deposit here, deposit there, it is essential to have good communication with your partner in order to optimize the preparation of the wedding. For our part, we also had planners/coordinators who accompanied us during the preparations and the wedding day. The OWN event company frees us from several tasks during preparation, we recommend it to all future brides and grooms!



-BRIDE AND GROOM: HOW DID YOU FEEL THE MORNING OF THE WEDDING?

In peace. This really describes us best on the morning of the wedding. When you know that God is in the middle of your relationship and has been with you throughout your relationship and the marriage planning process, there is no need to be stressed





-HOW DID YOU FEEL SEEING YOUR SPOUSE FOR THE FIRST TIME ON YOUR WEDDING DAY?

Bertho: Wowww! Beautiful! Sexy chocolate!

Lori Jessica: Awnnnnn! He was more emotional than me!

-WHAT ARE THE MOST MEMORABLE THINGS ABOUT YOUR WEDDING DAY?

The ceremony remains the most memorable memory of our wedding. Having taken place outside on a golf course, the view was magnificent and the weather was great! We were just watching the video this week and wow! Shoutout again at First Class!!

-IS THERE ANYTHING YOU WOULD HAVE DONE DIFFERENTLY ON YOUR WEDDING DAY, LOOKING BACK NOW?

Bertho: listen to your wife's choices!! 😂



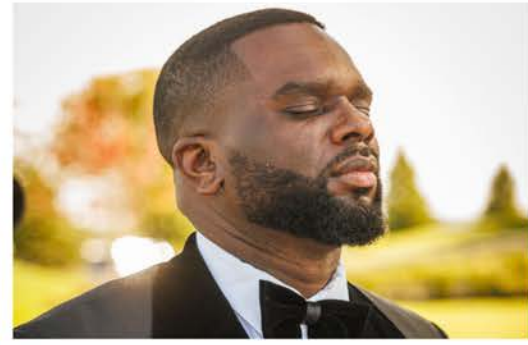

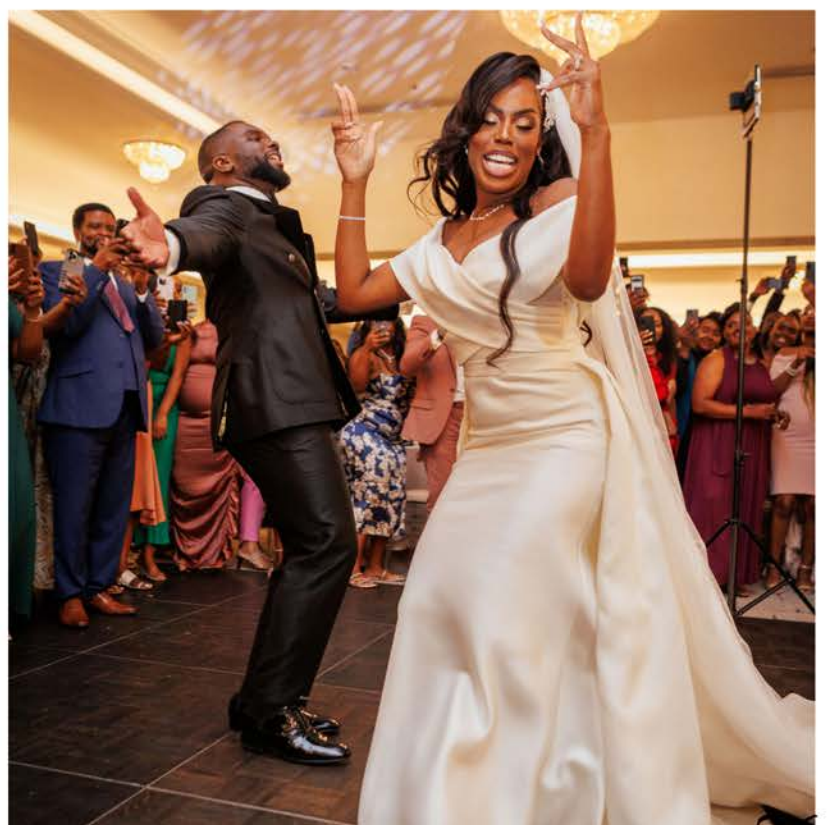

9 tips to follow before starting your wedding planning

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ORGANIZE YOUR WEDDING

Planning a wedding is both exciting and stressful. From deciding on the ceremony location to choosing your various service providers, there is so much to plan for! That's why today I would like to present to you 9 important points regarding planning your big day.

However, I would like to introduce myself, Bihanca Alphonse, project manager and organizer of events and weddings, officially since 2018. I am the founder of BihancaPlanning which offers several services including the organization of events and weddings. I am passionate about bringing the ideas of my various clients to life. My first wedding was in 2012, my parents' 25th wedding anniversary.

We celebrated like it was their first time, 375 guests, a ceremony, a cocktail, the reception and PARTY!!! And it was First Class Pictures who was our official photographer, while writing this article, I said to myself, what a don! In short, that's when I knew I was passionate about organizing a wedding or any event. But it can be a daunting task when you don't know the wedding or event industry.

This is why today I would like to share with you 9 points to take into account before embarking on the adventure of marriage.



9 tips to follow before starting your wedding planning

1-ARE YOU REALLY READY:

I strongly believe that marriage is something sacred, symbolic and not to be taken lightly.

When you say YES to yourself, it's supposed to be for life. Are you really ready to commit to this one and only person for life? Are you really financially ready?

With all the money and energy you're going to spend planning your wedding, trust me, it pays to be at least prepared. Ask yourself the real questions, analyze your finances, put money aside, don't rush and trust yourself.

2-DATE :

When do you want to get married? Do you want a warm wedding in the middle of July or do you prefer a winter wedding in December? Are you thinking of getting started in the months that

follow the marriage proposal or will you wait 1 year, or even 2 years, before making it official?



3-THEME:

Very often the clients who sign with me do not have a theme and sometimes even do not know what a wedding theme is for. I would tell you that a theme helps personalize your big day to your liking and also represents you as a couple. Having a theme provides consistency and coherence throughout the planning. Do some research, do you want a minimalist, classic chic, vintage, country, bohemian or oriental style wedding? There are several themes of wedding, choose one, it will help you know what you want.



9 tips to follow before starting your wedding planning

4-THE GUESTS:

Who should you send your invitations to? What is your ideal number of guests? Do you want a more intimate wedding with the people you care about including family and close friends? Where you want to go more broadly; with close and extended family, as well as friends and acquaintances, etc.



5-STYLE \GENRE :

Do you want a religious wedding, at the town hall or secular? Recently, I met a couple, whose man was Muslim and the woman Christian, when choosing the place of ceremony, it was a difficulty because both wanted to get married respecting their own religious values. The constraint: getting married in a mosque or in a church? Discuss this kind of detail in advance, will help you when the time comes to make your decision.



6-HIRE A WEDDING PLANNER OR ORGANIZE YOUR WEDDING YOURSELF?

Good question... Personally, I would say that this is a personal choice, but ask you: will I have the time and energy to organize my wedding? Some times the answer is yes, and other times it's no. Hiring a professional can help make your life easier, whether for the complete or partial organization or coordination of the big day. Montreal is full of wedding planners, so shop around. It is important to connect with the right person for you, because I always say, a wedding planner will become your best friend from the moment you sign the contract until the big day, so it is better to choose the right person.

7-SERVICE PROVIDERS

What kind of DJ are you looking for? Do you want an entertainer who will enhance your evening or do you prefer to leave it up to your guests to set the mood? Who would you choose to immortalize your big day? Remember that photos and videos are the memories that will allow you to relive this day whenever you want. Suppliers are important players in planning and for the big day, so take the time to do your research and to choose wisely or give the task to a professional who will be able to guide you.



8-BUDGET :

The budget is one of the most important points. Too many couples begin planning without setting a minimum or maximum goal. Setting a budget will allow you to know what you are capable of achieving, to know your limits and not to make a deficit. My advice: stick to your budget and don't compare yourself to others.



9-DELEGATE AND ENJOY:

Delegating to a professional, family or friends will take away a lot of stress and headaches and allow you to enjoy! Try to enjoy these moments with your loved one and make the process pleasant. Make sure your partner's opinion counts as much as yours, compromise because you won't always agree on the same points and HAVE FUN!

Instantly, we forget everything!

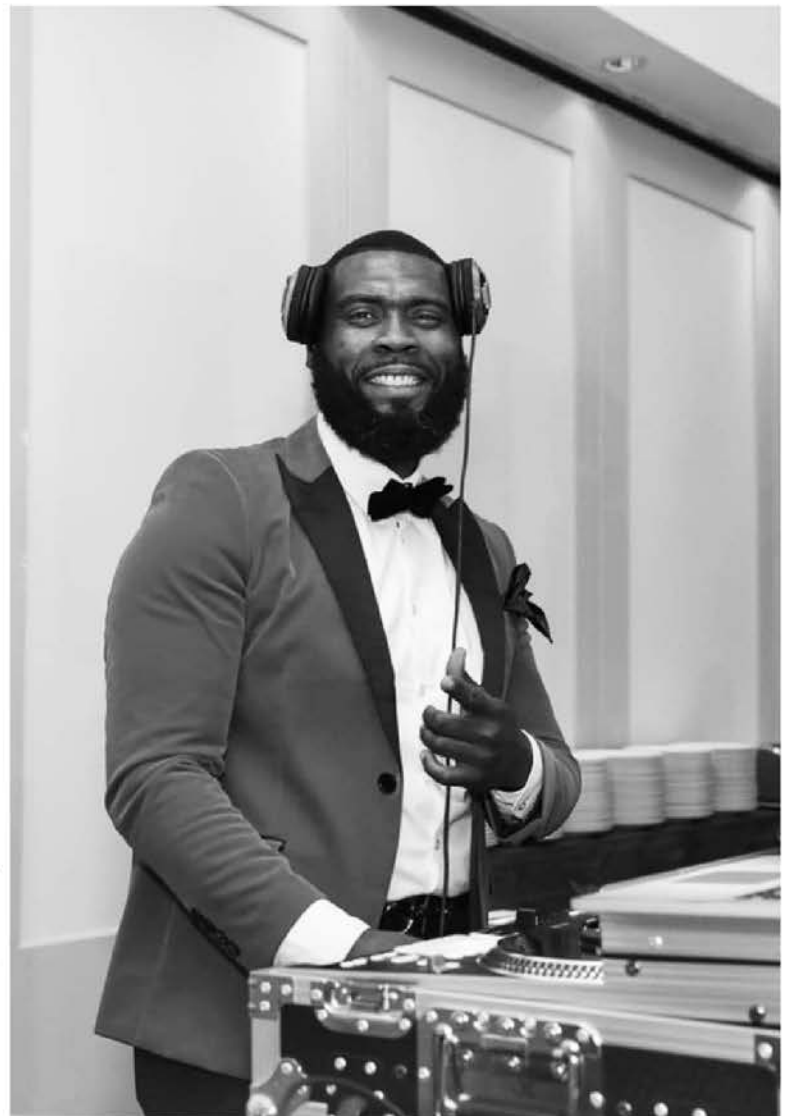

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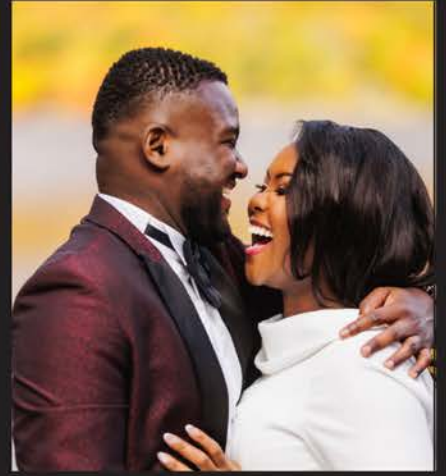
